



BASE Play RBI Security Policy

BASE Play is an after school program connecting 4th, 5th and 6th grade students to their own potential, their schools and community through baseball and softball play. **Though open to all students, BASE Play first targets students who are struggling academically or behaviorally.** Once this group has been identified and recruited to the program, any remaining team slots are open to the general student population on a first come-first serve basis.

There are two seasons each academic year, fall and spring. During the season, students participate in 2 practices per week after school. Practices are held on school grounds between 3pm and 5:30pm, depending on the school schedule. A meal is included as part of the program either before or after practice. For schools with buses, qualifying players will receive a bus ride back to their homes after practice. Games are held on Saturdays at the District's middle school fields.

Security Policy Purpose: The purpose of the BASE Play RBI Security Policy is to outline procedures to be taken by the RBI coaches and volunteers in the event safety is at risk during BASE Play RBI activities.

SAFETY IS OUR #1 PRIORITY!

The safety of BASE Play RBI players, coaches, volunteers, and supporters will ensure the life of the program. Safety can be threatened in a variety of ways. Some potential scenarios include:

- Someone on school grounds who is not permitted;
- Unsafe transition of players to sites (cafeteria to fields/ fields to player pick-up);
- Fights among students; and
- Students loitering around practice.

In the event that one of the above scenarios (or others) occur and pose a safety concern, please be sure to follow these procedures depending on the location and time of day there is a safety concern:
